REPLY TO APPELLANT STEELE'S RESPONSE TO
MOTION TO WITHDRAW AND MOTION FOR AFFIRMATIVE RELIEF

Pursuant to Fed. R. App. P. 27(a)(4), Appellee MLB Advanced Media,

L.P. ("MLBAM") respectfully submits this reply to Appellant Samuel Bartley

Steele's ("Steele") Response To Motion To Withdraw And Motion For Affirmative Relief ("Steele's Response") dated June 21, 2011.

On June 17, 2011, attorney Scott D. Brown filed a motion to withdraw as counsel for MLBAM on this appeal due to his departure from the law firm Skadden, Arps, Slate, Meagher & Flom LLP and a change in his employment. Steele and his counsel, Christopher A.D. Hunt ("Hunt"), have needlessly filed a response to this motion. Although they concede that this is a "routine, procedural motion[]," they nevertheless, once again, burden this Court -- and Appellee -- with well-worn, baseless assertions of "fraud on the court," which Steele acknowledges have been "repeatedly raised" and which are not relevant to this ministerial motion. (Steele Response at 5, 6.)

As to Steele's groundless allegations of purported wrongdoing,² counsel for MLBAM respectfully refer this Court to two recent District Court decisions that reject similar allegations by Steele and Hunt and impose Rule 11 sanctions in the form of an admonition. See Steele II, No. 10-11218-NMG,

Attorney Brown's change in employment is unrelated to this appeal, to Steele's three other appeals pending before this Court, or to the lawsuit currently pending in Massachusetts state court referred to by Steele.

Although MLBAM does not attempt to address every allegation, inaccuracy, or mischaracterization in Steele's Response, MLBAM obviously disputes Steele's factual assertions and is not conceding their accuracy.

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2011 WL 1882276, at *4 (D. Mass. May 17, 2011) (concluding that "sanctions are warranted here and [] Steele's proliferating lawsuits against essentially the same group of defendants border on harassment"); Steele III, No. 10-11458-NMG, 2011 WL 1897654, at *5 (D. Mass. May 18, 2011) (also imposing sanctions). In sum, this Court should disregard Steele's frivolous Response and authorize the clerk to grant Mr. Brown's "routine, procedural motion[]." (See Steele Response at 6.)
